FAMILY REUNIFICATION (Domestic up to 365 days)

Applicants who are citizens of countries other than Uganda, Rwanda, and/or Burundi are required to present a valid residence permit issued by the relevant authorities. These permits include a work permit, a student visa, and/or a dependent family member's permit.

- Completed long-stay visa application form (national visa), available on the Embassy website.
- Valid passport, with residual validity of at least three months beyond the planned travel dates
- A recent passport-sized photograph with a white background (size [ICAO](#))
- Clear photocopy of the personal data page of your passport, together with copies of recent visas and entry/exit stamps, clearly showing the actual size of the document
- Flight booking
- Proof of accommodation for the entire duration of your stay
- Consular fees payable only in cash and in USD on the day of the visa appointment

Specific documents

- Proof of family relationship, such as a marriage certificate and/or birth certificate, translated and certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Italian Embassy in the issuing country.
- Valid authorization issued by the Italian authorities. This authorization must be obtained before submitting the visa application.

MINORS

- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of the identity document of the parents and/or legal guardians
- Affidavit signed by the parent/legal guardian not traveling with the minor. The declaration must be certified by the competent Ministry of Foreign Affairs and translated into Italian for legalization by the consular office.
- In cases where one parent is absent or deceased, supporting documentation must be provided via a birth certificate, death certificate, or court order regarding custody. If the legal guardian is not the biological parent listed on the birth certificate, an official order confirming legal custody must be provided.
- Letter from the school indicating the name of the minor, the names of the parents/legal guardians, the class attended and the contact details of the school representative.
