Adoption Visa (National Visa up to 365 days)

Applicants who are citizens of countries other than Uganda, Rwanda, and/or Burundi are required to present a valid residence permit issued by the relevant authorities. These permits include a work permit, a student visa, and/or a dependent family member's permit.

- Long-stay visa [application form](#) duly completed
- Valid passport, with residual validity of at least three months beyond the planned travel dates
- A recent passport-sized photograph with a white background ([size ICAO](#))
- Clear photocopy of the personal data page of your passport, together with copies of recent visas and entry/exit stamps, clearly showing the actual size of the document
- Flight booking
- Proof of accommodation for the entire duration of your stay
- Valid travel health insurance covering the entire planned travel period, including transfer dates

Specific documents

- Certificate of suitability issued by the Juvenile Court with an apostille
- Authorization for entry and residence (nulla osta) issued by the Commission for International Adoptions
- Supporting civil status documents, namely:
 - Birth certificate of the minor
 - Copies of adoptive parents' identity documents/passports - Marriage certificate of the adoptive parents.
- Presence of both adoptive parents and the adopted minor at the time of submitting the visa application
