



AIRPORT TRANSIT AND MARITIME (Schengen from 1 to 90 days)

Applicants who are citizens of countries other than Uganda, Rwanda, and/or Burundi are required to present a valid residence permit issued by the relevant authorities. These permits include a work permit, a student visa, and/or a dependent family member's permit.

- Completed [application form](#) for a short-stay visa (Schengen visa), available through the dedicated form (also available on the Embassy website)
- Valid passport, with residual validity of at least three months beyond the planned travel dates
- A recent passport-sized photograph with a white background ([size ICAO](#))
- Clear photocopy of the personal data page of your passport, together with copies of recent visas and entry/exit stamps, clearly showing the actual size of the document
- Flight booking
- Proof of accommodation for the entire duration of your stay
- Personal bank statement stamped by the bank and covering the last three months
- Valid travel health insurance covering the entire planned travel period, including transfer dates
- Consular fees payable only in cash and in USD on the day of the visa appointment

Specific documents

- Valid visa for the country of subsequent or final destination
- Proof of intention to continue travel, such as a copy of a ticket or confirmed reservation for the next leg, accompanied by a clear and plausible explanation of the travel itinerary
- Seafarer's employment contract issued by the relevant employer
- Ship authorization issued by the competent Port Authority (Port Authority)
- Navigation program clearly indicating the expected dates of stay in the designated Italian port ☐
Seafarer's passport and/or navigation book (logbook)
