



DIPLOMATIC VISA (National up to 90 days)

The Diplomatic Visa allows entry into Italy to participate in institutional meetings, official missions, or government activities, for short stays of up to 90 days within a 180-day period.

To apply, you must complete and sign the National Form and provide the documentation listed below. The diplomatic visa is issued free of charge.

- Completed Visa [application form](#) (national visa), available on the Embassy website.
- Valid passport, valid for at least three months beyond the intended travel dates.
- A recent passport-sized photograph with a white background ([ICAO format](#))
- Round-trip air ticket reservation. It is not necessary to purchase the ticket before the Visa is issued.

Specific Documents

- Official Note Verbale issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, an international organization, or an Embassy.
- Official invitation letter from the inviting organization or institution, which must also be sent directly to the Visa Office before the appointment.
